Eligibility Criteria: To be eligible for State Government support, students must be an Australian Citizen **AND** meet **one** of the following:

- Students must undertake study at a higher level to any previous qualification currently held (upskilling)
- Students must be of 20 years of age or less as of the 1st of January 2020 (proof of age is essential if claiming 20 years or less).

Full Fee: If you are not eligible for State Government support, you will pay full fee – Fee for Service (FFS). The cost of FFS may vary from course to course. FFS charges are inclusive of all tuition and any other additional fees.

Tuition Fee: The fee associated with teaching and training services.

Total Fee: Is a total of Tuition fee + Administration fee + Resources/Materials fee + Amenities and is subject to change given individual circumstances at enrolment including Credit Transfer or RPL.

* **Resources/Materials Fee:** Additional non-teaching fee for extra costs associated with a course. Includes specialist materials and resources. Resources/Materials fee vary from course to course,
